As you may be aware, Hewlett Court was constructed in the nineteen seventies and is now over forty years old. In order that the Charity can maintain the high standards at Hewlett Court we have over the last few years had to invest in certain improvements to keep specifications up to date and meet current legislations. At the foremost of our minds during this time, has been the welfare and comfort of all the Residents.

The planned improvements to redevelop Hewlett Court, which commenced in February 2019, will certainly bring the facilities up to date; this will include the refurbishment of all the existing bedrooms including the installation of en suite bathroom facilities. The work has been twelve months in the planning with detailed discussions with Architects and Building Service consultants, and is currently being carried out in phases, with the projected completion date being spring 2020, the Charity have only been able to carry out this major refurbishment work thanks to a number of generous legacies.

To celebrate the completion of these works Hewlett Court will be holding a Summer Fair/Grand Opening on:


