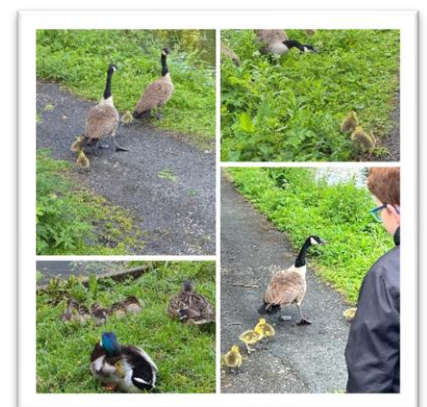
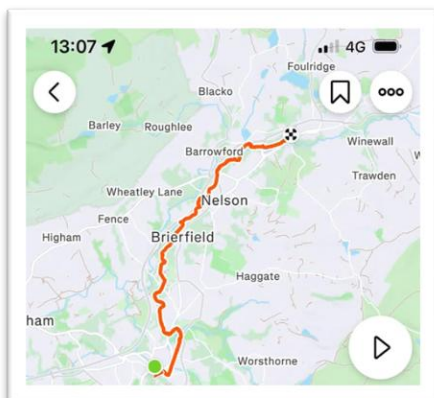

Cube Adapters

It has been noticed that several residents are using the cube plugs/adapter plugs in their rooms. Residents are reminded that cube plugs/adapter plugs are not recommended as discussed in the licensee meeting and advised by the fire service, they present a serious fire risk. Please use a suitable extension lead instead.

For safety reasons, extension leads mustn't be plugged in to extension leads as this can also be dangerous and increase the risk of fire.



Laundry Rooms

When using the laundry rooms, please ensure that the door is always left open when using the tumble drier. The laundry room can get excessively warm, which may interfere with the fire alarm system and could increase the risk of fire.

The ladies and gents truly had a fantastic time singing along to!



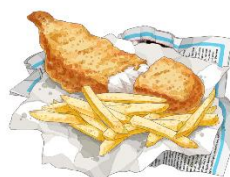
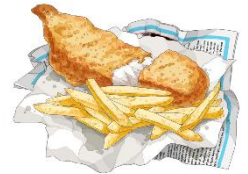

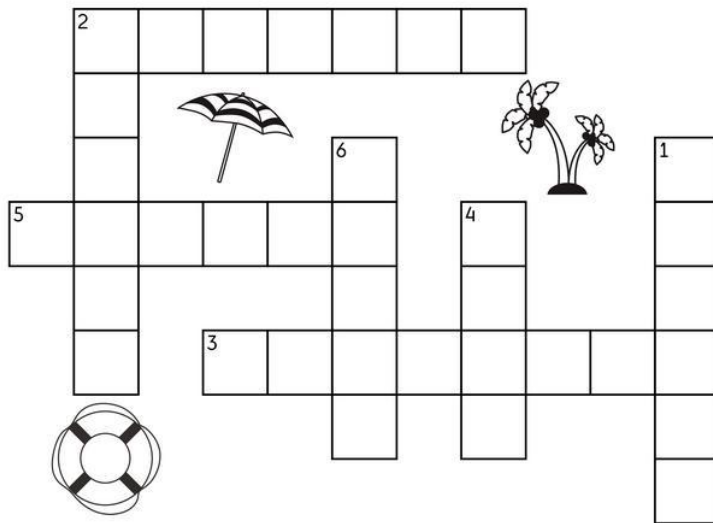
